

Science
 We will learn about plants, the different parts of plants and what they need to survive.

 We will also continue our learning about Animals including humans, this time looking at skeletons, muscles and movement

PSHCE
 Children will be learning about how learning takes place and reflecting on their attitudes to learning in particular considering the difference between a fixed and growth mindset. They will consider what makes a good talk partner and reflecting on our own skills and areas for development in this regard. Children will be focussing on using protective behaviour strategies to build resilience and help them keep safe and happy.

History

Geography
