The Aim of our School

Our aim is to work in partnership with parents to prepare each child, academically and socially, for a lifetime's learning. We will do our best to provide a caring and stimulating environment through a broad and balanced curriculum within which children can grow in confidence and self-discipline.

The School will do its best to:

- + care for the child's safety and happiness, listening to his/her needs
- + provide a broad, balanced curriculum that meets the needs of all children
- + ensure that your child plays a full part as a valued member of the school community
- + ensure that your child achieves the highest standards of achievement in both learning and behaviour
- + keep you informed about school matters, about your child's progress and welfare and to report any safeguarding concerns we may have
- + listen to parents, seek their views and act on feedback where necessary
- + approach every communication in a respectful way
- + safeguard children during the school day 8.50am to 3.15pm
- + monitor electronic communications between all stakeholders to ensure an e-safe environment
- + hold two parent consultation evenings each year and provide an annual written report for all full-time pupils

The Parents/Guardians - I/We shall do our best to:

- + ensure that my child goes to school regularly, on time (not before 8.50 and not after 9.00am).
- + ensure holidays are not taken during the school term or, if unavoidable, that prior permission is sought
- + ensure my child is **appropriately** dressed and has PE kit at school every day
- + contact the school on the first day of my child's absence (before 9.30am)
- + support the school's safeguarding, child protection and behaviour policies
- + attend parent's evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- + take an interest in my child's life at school
- + approach every communication in a respectful way
- + demonstrate good sportsmanship when attending school events
- + support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community
- + safeguard my child before 8.50am and after 3.15pm
- + let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- + ensure my child completes homework and support him or her with opportunities for home learning

The Pupil will do his or her best to:

- + ensure excellent attendance, getting to school on time (not before 8.50 and not after 9.00am), **appropriately** dressed and with the right equipment
- + demonstrate an excellent attitudes towards learning (classwork and homework)
- + keep the school's Golden Rules (a copy of which is printed overleaf)
- + show respect for all - be polite, helpful and well behaved towards all member of the school community
- + look after and take care of our school, equipment and other people's property
- + support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community

- + share information by means of parents' evenings and other discussions
- + deal sensitively with any complaints
- + support the activities of the PTA and/or Friends of Ashwell School
